



## State Route (SR) 60 Paving Project

### Project Description

In the cities of Chino and Ontario on SR-60, there are many concrete slabs damaged and in need of repair or replacement.

### Need and Purpose for Project

SR-60 is an important segment of the Alameda Goods Movement Corridor and is heavily traveled by tractor-trailers. This project will provide motorists with a smoother ride.

### Scope of Project

The rehabilitation will:

- » Replace approximately 200 slabs on the eastbound and westbound SR-60
- » Repair/Replace bridge approach and departure slabs
- » Upgrade guardrail
- » Rehab shoulders
- » Improve drainage

### Construction Impacts

Construction is scheduled to begin late winter 2007 and will last to early summer 2007. Work will typically take place overnight. Progressive lane closures will be used leaving at least two lanes open during work hours. Changeable message signs will be used to notify motorists of construction closures prior to SR-60.

### Construction Zone Driving Tips

Motorists will be encouraged to use alternate routes such as I-10 and SR-91. Merging early helps to ease congestion through the work area. A buffer zone and cones are all that separate vehicles from workers. For everyone's safety, please slow for the cone zone.
